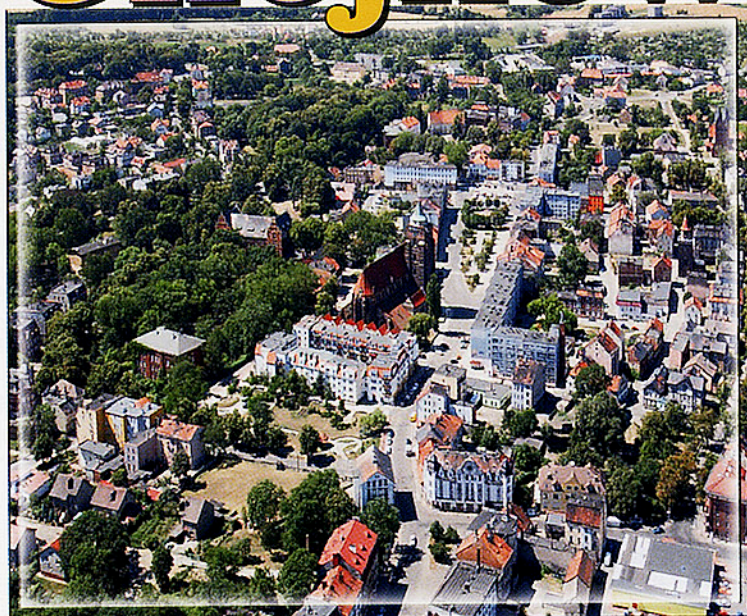

Chojnów – the region of economic possibilities

We are pleased to welcome You warmly in our small but beautiful town of Chojnów. The town is located in the Lower Silesian Voivodeship, very close to the border with Germany and Czech Republic, next to the A-4 motorway.

The history of Chojnów starts in the 13th century. Traces of its past can be found everywhere. Some of them are: the gothic church built at the turn of the 14th and 15th century – situated in the town centre, the neoroman style temple (which was erected at the beginning of the 20th century) and the old castle of the Piast of Legnica dynasty – rebuilt in the half of the 16th century in the renaissance style.

There is the Weaver Tower overlooking the town. The tower used to be a defensive building, now it symbolises urban craft traditions, which are commemorated by The Weaving and Artistic Handicraft Festival – the most important town event, which has been organising since a few years.

Among Chojnów's other attractions are two beautiful parks, countless squares and the greenery around crossing the town Skora river and the peacefulness of the Town Pond. Sport activities are widely accessible thanks to modern playing fields and sport halls which are a part of two primary schools and two junior high schools as well as of the group of colleges. There is also a project to build a municipal swimming pool.

The town offers to potential investors real estates and areas – all covered with the local spatial plan, intended for: business or industrial activities, a congested housing, a gastronomy and trade.

The most attractive to invest are areas within borders (since 2006) of the Legnica Special Economic Zone. There is a good technical infrastructure which covers the area of 6 hectares. Recently, the first investor just has started building a new factory.

The town of Chojnów also offers other industrial areas, more than 4 hectares.
